MCMC STATE OFFICES FACILITATE SERVICE PROVIDERS FOR SWIFT TELECOMMUNICATION RESTORATION IN FOUR FLOOD-HIT STATES

CYBERJAYA, 27 DECEMBER 2023 – The Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission (MCMC) sympathises with the flood victims in Kelantan, Pahang, Selangor, and Terengganu.

In these trying circumstances, MCMC recognises the indispensable role of telecommunications in enabling affected individuals to connect with their families.

As of 10 am today, there have been 110 transmission stations affected. 24 of these stations have been resolved and are now operational. The four state offices of MCMC are actively working on solutions for the remaining 86 stations that are still non-operational. They are collaborating closely with service providers to address these issues promptly.
