1.	<p><b>CCM/SSM</b> For Higher learning Public institutions to participate through the Faculty/School of Business, how about the SSM/CCM doc, which is a mandatory requirement. We only have "No Pewartaan [P.U. (A) 409/1971]- ditubuhkan dibawah perintah perbadanan. Seeking your clarification if we are entitled to participate in this tender with this doc.</p>	As per para 2.1 of the Tender Document, the Tenderer is required to have a valid certificate of registration issued by the Companies Commission of Malaysia. Public university programs can be proposed via its associate company (if any) or via collaboration with other learning providers, that fulfils the requirement of para 2.1.
2.	<p><b>Referring to section 42.5.</b> The Tenderer shall comprise at least three (3) personnel with at least ten (10) years of experience in leadership development, to carry out the Program on a full-time basis.</p> <p>To clarify this part further, the 3 personnel must be 10 years in leadership development or it can be from others as well for e.g Management.</p>	The tenderer is required to provide three (3) personnel with at least ten (10) years of experience in the leadership development area, however, the tenderer could propose a list of their distinguished personnel with relevant backgrounds whether in leadership development or other areas to carry out the Program on full-time basis.
3	<p>According to the below, Professional Certification must be awarded by a reputable institution. What constitutes a Professional Certification?</p> <p>(a) ALPs Graduation ceremony with MBA for reputable university/business school together with Professional Certification form a reputable institution.</p>	Example of reputable institutions are Data Science Certification bodies and Project Management certification bodies and the professional certification are such as Project Management Professional (PMP) and Prince 2.
4.	Can the MBA be a journey of 24 months as part of accreditation fulfilment?	Our proposed timeline for the program is a maximum of 18 months, however, tenderer could propose MBA journey based on their learning requirement.
5.	Would it be a deal breaker if we cannot offer professional certification on Project Management/Data Science but instead proposing for a Chartered Management Institute UK (CMI) professional certification instead? The reason being, there's no	Tenderer could propose an alternate reputable Professional Certification.

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	<p>professional bodies for data science that we know of, and a professional certification for Project Management (usually via PMI) requires its own specific course which PMI does not incorporate into an MBA programme. These 2 areas are already included in our MBA programme as electives but of course without professional certificate.</p>	
6.	<p>Do we need to submit full CV for each certified coaches we are proposing as well?</p>	<p>Yes, you may submit CV for each certified coach that you are proposing.</p>
7.	<p>To confirm, at the point of tender submission, we don't need to make any formal arrangement with any organisations/personnel for the Apply and Share stages, just proposing the organisations/personnel will do?</p>	<p>Yes, at the point of tender submission, you may just propose the organisations/personnel for Apply and Share Stage. Confirmation may be made later after agreement.</p>
8.	<p>For the MBA class/training, is it during weekend, weekdays or after office hour?</p>	<p>MBA class can be done preferably during weekend</p>
9.	<p>The assessment for the MBA, is it a project based or exam based?</p>	<p>Tenderer could determine type of assessment for MBA may it be project based or exam based.</p>
