WORLD RADIOCOMMUNICATION CONFERENCE 2019 (WRC-19) AGENDA ITEMS**

MCMC's efforts in developing Malaysia's positions and views for WRC-19 through the creation of National Preparatory Working Group for WRC ("NPWG") is much appreciated. The industry is fully aware of the importance of aligning the positions as it is for the betterment of spectrum management and telecommunications industry in Malaysia as well as Asia Pacific region. We applaud the structured approach and look forward to the continuous collaborations.

We are pleased to submit herewith Celcom's comments for the aforesaid public consultation paper for MCMC's consideration. Key responses are summarized as follow:

1. We support the Malaysia's positions/ views for Agenda Items 1.5, 1.11, 1.12, 1.13, 1.14, 1.16 and 9.1 (Issues 9.1.1, 9.1.2, 9.1.8, 9.1.9);
2. We propose for Malaysia to also identify and allocate 3300 – 3800MHz and 27.0 - 29.5GHz frequency bands for IMT; and
3. We propose for WRC to consider and study the 6GHz/ 7GHz frequency band as potential frequency band for IMT.
