


### C&M industry represents 8.7% of Bursa Malaysia market capitalisation



- C&M industry posted RM137.74 billion in market capitalisation or 8.7% of total Bursa Malaysia's capitalisation market RM1,579.59 billion
- The telecommunications sector is led by Maxis and Digi at 2.66% and 2.12% respectively

#### Resilient economic position for Malaysia C&M Industry




Market Capitalisation by sectors

#### C&M market capitalisation maintained at 8.7% in June 2020




- Percentage share industry on Bursa Malaysia maintained at 8.7% in June 2020 (January 2020: 8.7%)

#### Malaysia is ranked #3 in ASEAN for fixed-broadband average download speed




