


C&M industry represents 9.0% of Bursa Malaysia market capitalisation



- C&M industry posted RM142.49 billion in market capitalisation or 9.0% of total Bursa Malaysia's market capitalisation RM1,574.78 billion
- The telecommunications sector is led by Maxis and Digi at 2.62% and 2.25% respectively

Resilient economic position for Malaysia C&M Industry




Market Capitalisation by sectors

C&M market capitalisation increased to 9.0% in May 2020




- Percentage share of C&M industry on Bursa Malaysia increased to 9.0% in May 2020 (January 2020: 8.7%)
- The increase in market capitalisation is driven by the increase in demand for C&M industry (in particular for courier services and broadband internet) during **MCO** the period.

Malaysia is ranked #3 in ASEAN for fixed-broadband average download speed




