National Fiberisation and Connectivity Plan 2 (NFCP 2)

Following from the on-going COVID-19 pandemic impacting connectivity demand and the resultant JENDELA initiative, changes are necessary to, amongst others, enhance the specifications of NFCP 2 to improve coverage, speed and quality of connectivity for end users.

The Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission (MCMC) wishes to announce that after having considered the draft universal service plans submitted for NFCP 2, it has decided to reject all draft universal plans received by the Commission on 5 May 2020 as they do not meet the enhanced specifications required to address the new connectivity demand as determined in JENDELA. The Commission's decision is in accordance with Regulation 8(c) of the Communications and Multimedia (Universal Service Provision) Regulations 2002.

As such, the Commission will issue a revised Invitation to submit a draft universal service plan pursuant to Regulation 5 of the Communications and Multimedia (Universal Service Provision) Regulations 2002, on 20 November 2020 to ensure that the new specifications are met and the resultant outcome will improve coverage, speed and quality.
