1	 In the tender document (item No. 3 – Scope Of Work for Part 1) it is stated clearly that the tenderer; 3.5 Notwithstanding Item 3.4 above, subject to the Commission's approval, if the Site is found by the Part 1 Designated Universal Service Provider to be unsuitable, the Part 1 Designated Universal Service Provider may propose a change of the Site. The Part 1 Designated Universal Service Provider shall first attempt to identify a new site within two (2) kilometre radius from the Site which it considers suitable to meet the intended coverage objective with the same tower type and height as stated in Appendix 1 of this Invitation. But in the MCMC briefing on June 7, 2017 and inside the U1-RFP-Briefing-v4 document, it is stated that the tenderer didn't have to 'search' & 'identify' the location due to the facts that MCMC already performed the 'Site Hunting' and even to the extent of doing the 'Site Acquisition' (SAQ) initially. Do we need to produce the 'Site Details' as stipulated in the tender document? 	Item 3.5 of the RFP document refers to the Scope of Work for Part 1 during <u>project implementation</u> . For the purpose of submitting the proposal, the tenderer shall use the information provided in the RFP document and the site list shall not be changed. If the tenderer wishes to have further information, they have the option to carry out physical site survey based on the given site list. Yes, site details shall be provided in the submission.

2	In addition to our below enquiries, point 7.2 defines the documents which the tenderer need to prepare in Technical Proposal (Section B2 – Details of Technical Proposal) but contradicts MCMC's briefing in the slides provided. Below is the screen shot from the MCMC - USP - RFP - Ubiquitous Phase 1 document (page 25 – 7.2);	Please refer to the published amendment.
3	Commercial Power Supply - how far is the nearest Pole from U1 site?	The tenderer can either estimate the distance to the nearest pole or the tenderer can conduct physical site survey based on the given site list. The tenderer to decide which approach is preferred. As stated during the briefing, site details will only be provided upon the designation of the service provider.
4	Microwave – Where is the Far End?	The tenderer has the option to conduct detailed survey.
5	Who is the owner of the Far End?	The tenderer has the option to conduct detailed survey.

The Letter of Authorization shall be signed by company's top management who is authorized to do so.
15	It is understood that, the tenderer is not required to prepare and submit Technical Site Survey Report (TSSR) to MCMC as part of the Draft Plan, since the physical site survey were already been visited and identified by MCMC personnel for each site. Therefore, we would like to check with MCMC, if the TSSR report is going to be shared with the Tenderer in order for us to propose the suitable structure (for the identified site) i.e. 45m,	As stated during the briefing session, the detailed survey report will only be provided upon the designation of service provider. The tower type/height and requirement for double handling are already provided in the RFP.
