MCMC CONDUCTS PUBLIC CONSULTATION FOR INSTRUMENTS UNDER ONSA TO STRENGTHEN ONLINE SAFETY PROTECTIONS

CYBERJAYA, 12 February 2026 – The Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission (MCMC) today launched a Public Consultation on the proposed regulatory framework for the Online Safety Plan (OSP).

This includes the draft Risk Mitigation Code and Child Protection Code, as part of the implementation of the Online Safety Act 2025 (ONSA).

The proposed measures are designed to strengthen how online platforms manage safety risks, with a particular focus on protecting children, families and vulnerable groups.

The proposed regulatory framework and draft codes set clear expectations for service providers to take reasonable and proportionate steps to mitigate the risk of online harms in a practical manner.

Through this Public Consultation, MCMC invites the public to play an active role in shaping a safer online ecosystem, including providing views on the effectiveness and practicality of the proposed measures in enhancing online safety protections.

Members of the public, industry players, civil society organisations and other interested parties are encouraged to review the consultation documents and submit their feedback.

The public are encouraged to review the consultation documents and submit their written submissions to MCMC, either in hard copy or electronic form, by **5.00PM on 13 March 2026**.
