COMMISSION DETERMINATION ON THE MANDATORY STANDARDS FOR THE REGISTRATION OF END-USERS OF PREPAID PUBLIC CELLULAR SERVICES, DETERMINATION NO. 1 OF 2026

CYBERJAYA, 26 February 2026 – The Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission (“MCMC”) hereby issues this notice on the Commission Determination on the Mandatory Standards for the Registration of End-Users of Prepaid Public Cellular Services, Determination No. 1 of 2026 (“Mandatory Standard”).

Pursuant to Sections 55 and 61 of the Communications and Multimedia Act 1998 (“CMA 1998”), MCMC conducted a Public Inquiry from 14 October 2025 to 28 November 2025, to seek input from industry players, stakeholders, and members of the public regarding the proposed Mandatory Standard.

Based on feedback from the Public Inquiry, MCMC has refined the Mandatory Standards to strengthen prepaid SIM registration controls, enhance consumer protection and mitigate fraud risks. The refined regulatory framework reinforces secure and technology-neutral registration methods, formalises SIM ownership limits, and strengthens age-based safeguards for prepaid registration, with clearer operational requirements to support traceability and effective enforcement.

Pursuant to Sections 55 and 104(1)(b) of the CMA 1998, MCMC hereby issues the **Commission Determination on the Mandatory Standards for the Registration of End-Users of Prepaid Public Cellular Services, Determination No. 1 of 2026**.
